School entrance procedure

- ✓ Families can apply for their children to take the entrance tests through the server :
From **Monday 29 January to Monday 12 March (midnight)**
- ✓ All paper dossier must be returned to the school by :
Thursday **15 March 2018 (date as per postmark)**

Application to the entrance tests will be filled in by the families on the server via the school website:

Once the complete application file is returned to us, a receipt will be sent to you by post.

Official summons to the written and oral tests will be sent between **3 and 6 April 2018**, by post.

Entrance tests

Derogation

Important reminder: in the department of Isère, for enrolment in 6ème, only one derogation is permitted.

Exclusively for enrolment in 6ème, a passing mark on the entry test in the international section is automatically considered a request for derogation.

Therefore, you are required to report the entry test for which you have applied as a request for derogation for the *collège* Europole under the subheading « parcours particulier ». This information should appear in the enrolment documents that will be sent to you by the primary school administration to whom these documents must be returned.

***In the case that your child is not admitted to the *collège* Europole, he/she will automatically be assigned to the school in his/her local sector.**

*The only exception to this may concern students coming from international or bilingual sections in elementary schools whose local secondary school does not provide further bilingual education. For information concerning school assignment in 6ème, please contact your child's current school administration.
