Andy Goldsworthy, born in 1956, is a British sculptor, photographer and environmentalist producing site-specific sculpture and land art situated in natural and urban settings. He lives and works in Scotland.

The materials used in his art often include brightly-coloured flowers, icicles, leaves, mud, pinecones, snow, stone, twigs and thorns.

Photography plays a crucial role in his art due to its often ephemeral and transient state.

Goldsworthy is generally considered the founder of modern rock balancing (an art in which rocks are balanced on top of one another in various positions)
